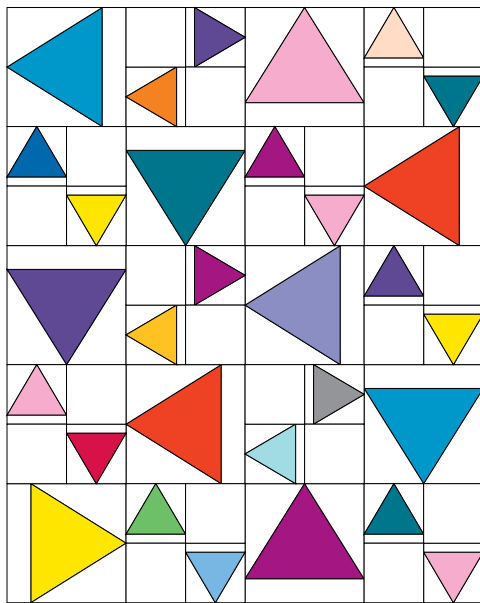

Size Options

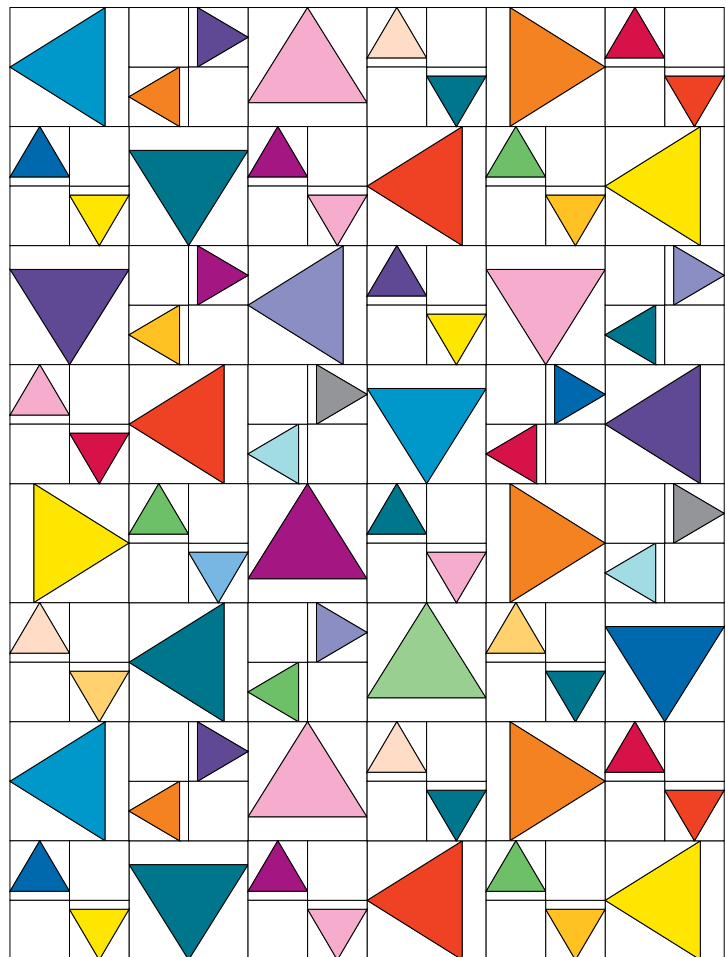
	Crib (40" x 50")	Twin (60" x 80")
Blocks	20	48

Materials

Assorted Solid Fabrics	10 fat quarters	24 fat quarters
White Solid	1¼ yards	4 yards
Binding Fabric	½ yard	⅝ yard
Backing Fabric	1⅝ yards	5 yards
Batting	Crib-size	Twin-size

Cutting

Crib Size

From fat quarters, cut a total of:

- 10 A triangles and 20 D triangles.

From white solid, cut:

- 2 (8¾"-wide) strips. From strips, cut 10 B triangles and 10 B reverse triangles.
- 4 (5½"-wide) strips. From strips, cut 20 (5½") squares and 20 (5½" × 1¼") F rectangles.
- 2 (5"-wide) strips. From strips, cut 20 E triangles and 20 E reverse triangles.
- 4 (2½"-wide) strip. From strips, cut 10 (2½" × 10½") C rectangles.

From binding fabric, cut:

- 5 (2¼"-wide) strips for binding.

Twin Size

From fat quarters, cut a total of :

- 24 A triangles and 48 D triangles.

From white solid, cut:

- 4 (8¾"-wide) strips. From strips, cut 24 B triangles and 24 B reverse triangles.
- 9 (5½"-wide) strips. From strips, cut 48 (5½") squares and 48 (1¼" × 5½") F rectangles.
- 5 (5"-wide) strips. From strips, cut 48 E triangles and 48 E reverse triangles.
- 7 (2½"-wide) strips. From strips, cut 24 (2½" × 10½") C rectangles.

From binding fabric, cut:

- 8 (2¼"-wide) strips for binding.
